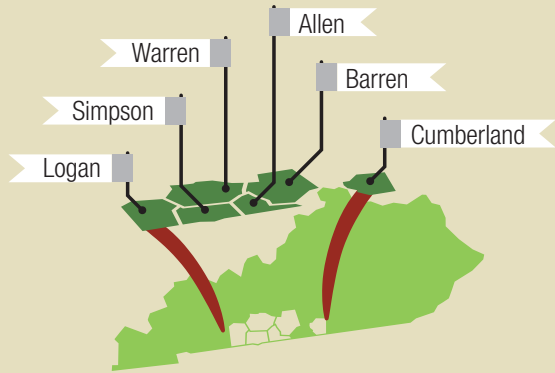


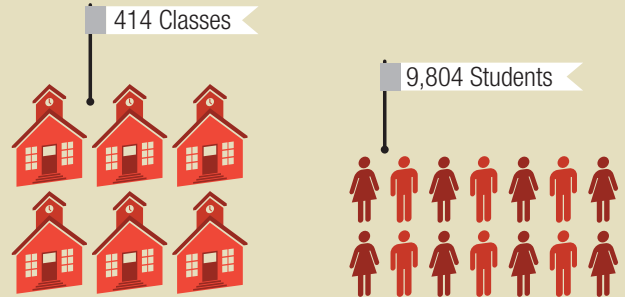

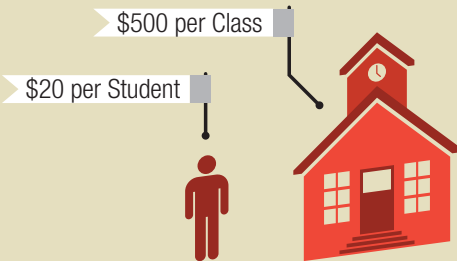


JA's Impact

Cost Per Class & Student



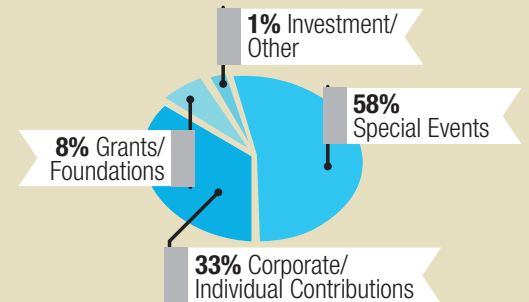

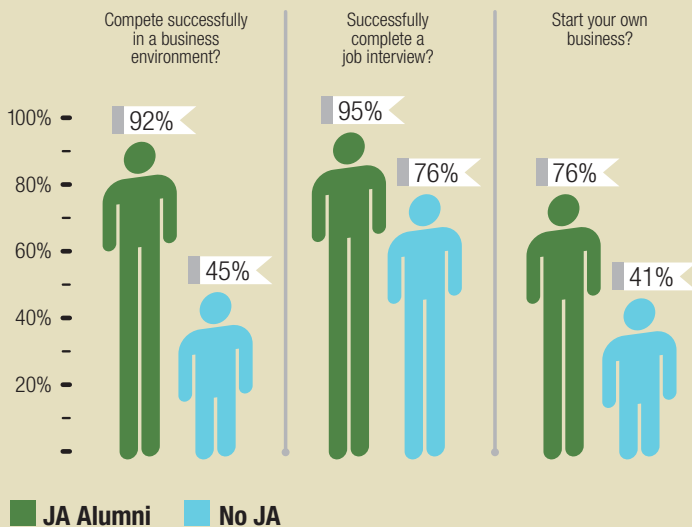
